21st Nov. - Day 1: Tokyo Full Day City Tour

Visit:

Sky Tree: Sky Tree is a Broadcasting and Observation tower in Sumida, Tokyo. It became the tallest structure in Japan in 2010 and reached its full height of 635 Mts, making it the tallest tower in the world.

Asakusa Sensoji: Sensoji: (浅草寺, Sensōji, also known as Asakusa Kannon Temple) is a Buddhist temple located in Asakusa. It is one of Tokyo's most colourful and popular temples. Sensoji was built nearby for the goddess of Kannon. The temple was completed in 645, making it Tokyo's oldest temple.

Nakamise Shopping Street: A shopping street of over 200 meters, called Nakamise, leads from the outer gate to the temple's second gate, the Hozomon. Alongside typical Japanese souvenirs such as yukata and folding fans, various traditional local snacks from the Asakusa area are sold along the Nakamise. The shopping street has a history of several centuries.

Sumida Cruise: Sumida River has acted as Tokyo's gateway to the sea since ancient times. This access to the ocean has always attracted both people and business, and even today, you'll spot many a ship sailing on the rivers and Tokyo Bay

Team Labs: Team Lab is an international art collective, an interdisciplinary group of artists formed in 2001 in Tokyo, Japan. The group consists of artists, programmers, engineers, CG animators, mathematicians and architects who refer to themselves as "ultra-technologists". Team Lab creates artworks using digital technology.

City Orientation Tour

Shibuya Crossing: Shibuya Scramble Crossing, commonly known as Shibuya Crossing, is a popular pedestrian scramble crossing in Shibuya, Tokyo, Japan. It is located in front of the Shibuya Station Hachikō exit and stops vehicles in all directions to allow pedestrians to inundate the entire intersection.

National Diet Building: The National Diet Building (国会議事堂, Kokkai-gijidō) is the building where both houses of the National Diet of Japan meet. Sessions of the House of Representatives take place in the south wing and sessions of the House of Councillors in the north wing.

Imperial Palace: The Imperial Palace (皇居, Kōkyo, literally 'Imperial Residence') is the main residence of the Emperor of Japan. It is a large park-like area located in the Chiyoda district of the Chiyoda ward of Tokyo.

Nikko Toshogu Shrine: Nikkō Tōshō-gū (日光東照宮) is a Tōshō-gū Shinto shrine located in Nikkō, Tochigi Prefecture, Japan

Together with Futarasan Shrine and Rinnō-ji, it forms the Shrines and Temples of Nikkō UNESCO World Heritage Site, with 42 structures of the shrine included in the nomination.

23rd Nov: Day 3 - Tokyo – Hakone – Nagoya - Full Day Trip of Mt Fuji & Hakone

(Today, you will transfer Baggage to Osaka. 1 Bag per person 23 Kgs Max.)

Visit:

Mt. Fuji 5th Station (Subject to Weather Conditions): Located on the Yamanashi Prefecture side, serves as the gateway to Mount Fuji's summit. It offers an enjoyable experience not only for mountain climbers but also for tourists as a popular sightseeing spot.

Owakudani Boiling Valley: The result of a volcanic eruption over 3,000 years ago, Owakudani is a volcanic valley with active Sulphur vents and hot springs. This area is one of the most famous tourist attractions in Hakone due to its volcanic activity and striking scenic views—you can even catch an amazing view of Mt. Fuji on a clear day.

Hakone Ropeway to Togendai: Desolate mountainside covered by plumes of smoke produce a distinct scene so fitting the area's former name of Hell Valley. Now, the Hakone Ropeway rising above Owakudani. Traveling from Owakudani to Lake Ashi, passengers they can enjoy views of Mt. Fuji and Lake Ashi.

Pirate Cruise Lake Ashi: Replicas of pirate ships cruise Lake Ashi, offering views of forests, hotels and the striking red gateway to the Hakone Shrine.

Bullet Train to Nagoya. Reserved Seat Ordinary Class: Post the sightseeing travel to Nagoya through Bullet Train.

Toyota Commemorative Museum: Built in the birthplace of the Toyota Group, the museum preserves the original early 20th century plant as industrial heritage. It allows visitors to experience the changes in textile technology that underpinned the development of modern Japan and in automobile technologies that are still breaking through new horizons today, through the dynamic exhibits and demos of actual machinery.

SC Maglev Museum: On 21 April 2015, a manned seven-car L0 Series SC Maglev train reached a speed of 603 km/h (375 mph), less than a week after the same train clocked 590 km/h (370 mph), breaking the previous land speed record for rail vehicles of 581 km/h (361 mph) set by a JR Central MLX01 maglev train in December 2003. 26th Nov: Day 6 - Osaka – Nara – Kyoto – Osaka - Full Day Trip of Nara & Kyoto from Osaka

Visit:

Todaiji Temple & Nara Deer Park: Since it was built in the Nara period, it suffered two wars, one in Jisho and the other in Eiroku, and the current building was rebuilt in the Edo period by Kokei Shonin. However, the Great Buddha Hall in Tenpyo and Kamakura had a girder line of 11 ken (about 88 m), but due to financial difficulties, the scale was reduced to 7 ken. Still, the height and depth remain the same as when it was first built, making it one of the largest wooden structures in the world.

Kinkaku-ji (金閣寺, literally "Temple of the Golden Pavilion"), officially named Rokuon-ji (鹿苑寺, lit. 'Deer Garden Temple'), is a Zen Buddhist temple in Kyoto, Japan. It is one of the most popular buildings in Kyoto, attracting many visitors annually. It is designated as a National Special Historic Site, a National Special Landscape and is one of 17 locations making up the Historic Monuments of Ancient Kyoto which are World Heritage Sites

Arashiyama Bamboo Grooves & Togetsu Bridge: Arashiyama is a district on the western outskirts of Kyoto, Japan. It also refers to the mountain across the Ōi River, which forms a back drop to the district. Arashiyama is a nationally designated Historic Site and Place of Scenic Beauty.

27th Nov: Day 7- Full Day Trip of Osaka.

Osaka Castle: Osaka Castle (大坂城 or 大阪城, Ōsaka-jō) is a Japanese castle in Chūō-ku, Osaka, Japan. The castle is one of Japan's most famous landmarks and it played a major role in the unification of Japan during the sixteenth century. The main tower of Osaka Castle is situated on a plot of land roughly one square kilometre. It is built on two raised platforms of landfill supported by sheer walls of cut rock, using a technique called burdock piling, each overlooking a moat. The central castle building is five stories on the outside and eight stories on the inside, and built atop a tall stone foundation to protect its occupants from attackers.
